**Sub:** Grant of concession to delegates attending Annual Conference of Indian Federation of working journalists.

Telex/post copy received from Railway Board is reproduced below:-

“ As per S.No. 18 (1) of Annexure to rule 101 of IRCA Coaching Tariff No. 25, Part I (Vol-II) , the delegates attending Annual Conference of Indian Federation of Working journalists are eligible for 25% concession in second/sleeper class fares, subject to certain conditions. This organization has requested for grant of 50% concession to the delegates attending the triennial plenary session at Rajgir Feb, 2010. Ministry of Railways have agreed to the request and decided to grant 50% concession in Second/sleeper class to persons with earnings/emoluments of not more than Rs. 5000/- per month attending the triennial plenary session being organized by **Indian Federation of Working Journalists**, New Delhi to be held at Rajgir( Bihar) during 19<sup>th</sup> to 22th February, 2010. This concession has been granted as a very special case and should not be quoted as a precedent. This concession is admissible only in normal train services and not for booking of Special Trains/Coaches. The concessional return journey tickets may be issued on payment of one single journey Second/Sleeper class Mail/Express fares, to the persons traveling more than 300 Kms. from the journey commencing station to the station serving the place of the seminar on production of the requisite certificate from the Secretary General of the above mentioned organization. Necessary instructions may be issued to the staff concerned immediately. This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways .Mater Most Urgent.”
