<u>Sub:</u> Dynamic Pricing Policy-Levy of Development Surcharge and Busy Season Charge.

Ref: 1. TCR/1078/2007/6 dated.29.05.2007(RC -58/2007)

2. TCR/1078/2008/11 dated.29.03.2011(RC -13/2011)

1. In supersession of Para-1 of Board's letter No. TCR/1078/2007/6 dt.29.05.2007 [(RC-58 of 2007) circulated vide CCM/ECoR's Commercial Circular No.124(G)/07 dated 31.05.2007], sanction of the Central Government is hereby accorded to the levy of 5%(Five Percent) Development Surcharge on all Goods Traffic. This will be levied on Normal Tariff Rate(NTR).

2. In supersession of Para-1 of Board's letter No. TCR/1078/2008/11 dated 29.03.2011 [(RC-13 of 2011) circulated vide CCM/ECoR's Commercial Circular No.35(G)/2011 dated 29.03.2011], sanction of the Central Government is hereby accorded to levy Busy Season Charge at the rates mentioned in the table below during the Busy Season extending from 1st October 2011 to 30th June 2012:

S. No.	Commodities	Rate
1.	All Commodities	10%
2.	Container Traffic	Nil
3.	Automobile Traffic moved in NMG, BCACM& BCCNR wagons	Nil

- 3. The Busy Season Charge will be levied on the applicable Base Freight Rates published in the IRCA Goods Tariff Part-II as amended from time to time.
- 4. The Base Freight Rates as mentioned in IRCA Goods Tariff Part-II as amended from time to time alongwith Demand Management charges like Busy Season Charge, Congestion Charge and Supplementary Charge on various transportation products will constitute Normal Tariff Rate (NTR).
- 5. Thus, NTR will comprise of Base Freight Rate and various demand Management Charges under Dynamic Pricing Policy. Other charges like Punitive Charges for overloading, Penal Charges for Misdeclaration will be levied on NTR. Similarly, freight concession (discount/rebate) will also be granted on NTR.
- 6. These instructions will come into effect from 15.10.2011 and will remain in force till further advice.
- 7. This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of Ministry of Railways.

All concerned to note and act accordingly.
