

PROGRAMME TO MARK 3 GLORIOUS DECADES OF MANCHESWAR WORKSHOP

Carriage Repair Workshop Mancheswar, the only workshop of East Coast Railway has completed 3 decades of production in December 2013. The first coach after Periodic Overhauling (POH) was turned out from Mancheswar Workshop on 31.12.1983 in presence of Shri C. K. Jaffer Sharief, the then Hon'ble Minister of State for Railways. Since then, the workshop has moved forward and became no. 1 productive workshop in Indian Railways by registering highest productivity in first three quarters of 2013-14.

To mark completion of 3 decades, various programmes were held in the workshop and colony. It started with a Blood Donation Camp organized in association with Indian Redcross and Central hospital East Coast Railway on 25.1.2014 in the First-Aid-Centre inside the workshop. A record 114 units of blood was donated by the staff.
