NOTIFICATION

SUB: Re-engagement of Retired employees – Para-medical staff in Medical department on Waltair Division, East Coast Railway to meet exigencies of service.

Applications are invited on the prescribed format annexed to this letter from the retired Para-medical Railway employees of Waltair Division for re-engagement against the vacancies in the Medical department of Waltair Division as indicated below on the terms and conditions as applicable, who are below the age of 65 years as on 22-02-2018 ( cut-off date ) for the posts as detailed hereunder:



The re-engagement is subject to the following conditions:

1. The scheme is valid upto 01-12-2019. [RBE 193/2017]
2. Employees who have retired normally from Waltair Division ( superannuated staff ) from the departments and posts cited above only are eligible to apply.
3. The re-engagement is being made in the exigencies of service and will be confined to the available vacancies. The re-engaged staff will be discharged in either of the following conditions:
  - (a) on attaining the age of 65 years of age, or, on completion of validity of the scheme i.e. 01-12-2019, whichever is earlier.
  - or,
  - (b) till the vacancies are filled up by the regularly selected candidates through RRB / RRC / Departmental tests,
  - or,
  - (c) at any point of time when the Administration feels there is no further exigency to resort / continue re-engagement of retired staff,
  - or
  - (d) in the case the work/ conduct of the re-engaged staff is not found satisfactory during such re-engagement.
4. The re-engagement shall be subject to the ex. employee being medically fit for the post and being adjudged suitable by the nominated Committee but shall not be automatic.
5. Monthly remuneration of a retired employee being re-engaged will be determined by reducing Pension from his/her last pay drawn ( i.e. Basic Pay + DA )

6. The duty hours of the re-engaged employee would be prescribed by the concerned Branch Officer as per the working conditions of the post.
7. Self-attested copies of the following documents should be attached with the application:
  - (a) Service certificate.
  - (b) PPO
  - (c) Pensioner Identity card.
8. The last date for submission of applications is **16-03-2018**. Retired staff fulfilling the conditions stated above who are desirous for re-engagement have to submit the applications in the prescribed format annexed to this notification to the Recruitment Section or place them in the Drop Box kept in Sr.DPO's Office, DRM Office Complex, Waltair on or before 16-03-2018.
