

Sub:- Formation of Group-B/Law Panel of LO(Level-8, Pay Matrix, Rs.47,600-Rs.1,51,100/- (GP Rs.4800/-, VIth PC) in Law Department of East Coast Railway/ Bhubaneswar for one post for the Assessment Period 2017-19.

The competent authority has decided to hold written test for Group-B selection for formation of Gr.B/Law Panel for 01 (UR) post of Law Officer (Level-8, Pay Matrix, Rs.47,600-Rs.1,51,100/-, GP Rs.4800/-, VIth PC) in Law Department of ECoR/BBS for the assessment period 2017-19. The exact date, time and venue of written test examination will be intimated on in due course.

A provisional seniority list of 05 nos. (1 x 5 = 5) of Chief Law Assistant of Law Department who have completed minimum 02 years of non-fortuitous service in level-7, Pay Matrix Rs.44900- Rs.1,42,400/- (GP-Rs.4600/- VIth PC) and above as on 01.04.2017 (Cut off date) and are coming in the zone of consideration is enclosed at Annexure 'A'. Also an additional list of 10 nos. of Chief Law Assistant of Law Department who have also completed 02 years of non-fortuitous service in level-7, Pay Matrix Rs.44900- Rs.1,42,400/- (GP-Rs.4600/- VIth PC) and above as on 01.04.2017 (Cut-off date) is enclosed provisionally at Annexure-B as stand-byes (Reserve list). Against any unwilling candidate of Annexure-A, the willing candidate of Annexure-B may be called for to the extent of making good the zone of consideration. The candidature of the candidates is accepted provisionally. In case any candidate is found ineligible for the above selection at any stage, his candidature will be rejected. As per rule Group-B/ Law is a non-safety category of post.

The eligible candidates whose names are borne in the provisional integrated seniority list of Law Department (Annexure-'A' & 'B') should submit their willingness or unwillingness on or before **27.04.2018** in the attached counterfoil format and the same should be sent to the Dy.CPO(Gaz)/ECoR/BBS **08.05.2018** positively in a consolidated list along with the individual options. It is the employee's responsibility to advise his willingness/unwillingness to take the selection, and failure to respond or provide the intimation within the period allowed will be

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treated as unwillingness on his part to take the selection. If willingness/unwillingness is not received within the above mentioned stipulated date, it will be deemed that the candidate has availed of the opportunity of appearing in the selection. In case any candidate is on leave or on deputation to other Railways/Units/office or on sick list, the Controlling officer concerned and the offices where he last worked should send necessary advice to the authority under whom he is working or the Medical Authority as the case may be and an acknowledgement obtained. Applications of the staff concerned need not be sent to this office directly. Controlling officers should ensure that applications received by their officers after **27.04.2018** are not forwarded to HQs office under any circumstance.

Names of those staff who have not fulfilled the eligibility criteria as mentioned above need not be forwarded. It may also be noted that incomplete statements furnished by the divisions/units will not be entertained.

The Pre-selection coaching for a period of 3-4 weeks to the reserved community (SC/ST) candidates should be arranged by the Executive side. As it is mandatory, refusal, if any should be taken in writing.

(A) Objective and Scheme of Examination- The examination aims at a comprehensive assessment of knowledge of the candidates and is essentially aimed at testing their professional ability. The examination will consist of : (i) Written Examination (ii) Viva-voce (with prior Medical Fitness test).

(N.B : For written test, the prescribed syllabus as contained in Railway Board's Letter No. E(GP)2015/2/20, dated 14.12.2016 for Professional subject of LO(Gr.B) will be followed.)

The subjects for examination and marks allotted for one Professional paper and viva-voce as indicated in Railway Board's letter No.E(GP)88/2/111 dated 20.08.1991, are mentioned below:-

(i) Written Examination

Professional Paper-I (Professional Subject, Establishment Rules & Financial Rules & Official Language Policy& Rules)	150	90	3 hrs.	Medical fitness before viva-voce is required.

NOTE: Out of 150 marks, the questions relating to the professional subject will carry at least 100 marks. Besides, there would be questions on official language policy and rules to the extent of 10% of total marks but such of the questions are not compulsory. The duration of the written examination will be of **03 hrs.**

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There will be subjective and some objective type of questions in the written test. Objective type questions will include only Multiple Choice questions and numbering of indicative answers to these questions and replies to such answers by the candidates should invariably be given in Capital Letters only.

The candidates are advised to write their names, designations, examination details, total pages used only on the top sheet of the Answer Booklet and nowhere else. The candidates are also instructed that if they write their names, designations, roll numbers or put any other symbol/mark anywhere else in the Answer Booklet, their candidature will be cancelled. The candidates should pen through the blank spaces left in their Answer Booklets & write total pages used on the space provided at the TOP sheet of the Answer Booklets.
