Sub: Preferential traffic and priority of indents for rake allotment.

A case has been brought to the notice of Board where priority was accorded to an indent over other indents in the same class as the sender has opted for carriage by a longer route under Rule No. 125 (2) of Goods Tariff No. 41 Part -I Vol. I .

The issue has been reviewed. It is clarified that the provision of Para 5.2 (d) of the PTO G.O. No.87 [Circulated vide CCM/ECOR's Circular No.94(G)/2014 dtd. 01.08.2014] regarding priority to traffic offered for distance of more than 700 Kms within the same classification would not apply in cases where the distance of more than 700 kms is on account of the sender opting for a longer route.

All concerned to note and act accordingly.
