Sub: Exemption from mandatory(100%) weighment for the commodities loaded in standard bags of uniform size

Ref: Rate Master Circular/Weighment/2014/0 (Circulated vide this office Commercial Circular No.84(G)/2014 dtd.14.07.2014)

Please refer to Para 3.1 of rates Master circular under reference regarding exemption from mandatory(100%) weighment for the commodities loaded in standard bags of uniform size.

A query has been raised as to what constitutes "standard bags of uniform size". In this regard, it is stated that the term denotes all such bags of standard size having pre-stenciled/pre- printed weight mentioned on them and which are filled uniformly through an automated system having a pre-weighing mechanism that ensures the weight of the commodity being filled in each bag is as per the pre-stenciled/pre-printed weight and that such system has been duly certified by Weights and Measures Deptt.

This issues with the concurrence of Finance Dte. of Ministry of Railways.

All concerned to note and act accordingly.


