**Sub: Rebate in freight for traffic transported in privately owned wagons.**

1.0 Sanction of the Central Government is hereby accorded to grant rebate in freight for Caustic Soda/Caustic Soda lye/Caustic Soda Liquor, Alumina, Furnace Oil and Bulk Cement when loaded and transported in privately owned wagons as under:

- 2.0 The rebate in freight in case of Furnace oil, Ammonia (Anhydrous Liquefied Gas) and Phosphoric Acid will be applicable for the stream(s) notified by the Operating department of the Zonal Railways in consultation with Traffic Transportation Directorate in the Ministry of Railways.
- 3.0 The rebate in freight charges for both Ammonia (Anhydrous Liquefied Gas) and Phosphoric Acid in privately owned tank wagons may be allowed at the time of booking in respect of those parties who have paid the annual maintenance charges in advance at the commencement of the year. The transfer of tank wagon from owner of such wagons to parties hiring such wagons for transportation of the commodities should have the prior approval of Traffic Transportation Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.
- 4.0 The aforementioned rebate should be applicable only to wagons notified vide following commercial circulars
- (i) NALCO: 820 wagons (90-BTCS, 30-BTPN, 700-BTAP) listed in CCM/ECOR's Commercial Circular No.127(G)/2013 dtd.11.11.2013.
- (ii) Vedanta Aluminium Ltd: 62 BTCS wagons listed in CCM/ECOR's Commercial Circular No.131(G)/2011 dtd.25.11.2011 & 74(G)/2013 dtd.18.06.2013.
- (iii) Hindalco Industries Ltd: 159 BTAP wagons listed in CCM/ECOR's Commercial Circular No.44(G)/2014 dtd.22.04.2014
- (iv) Bharat Aluminium Co. Ltd: 160 BTAPHP wagons listed in CCM/ECOR's Commercial Circular No.38(G)/11 dtd.26.04.2011, 74(G)/11 dtd.15.07.2011, 07(G)/2013 dtd.10.01.2013
- All other instructions issued from time to time for aforesaid wagons should be strictly followed.
- 5.0 The percentage rebate indicated above would remain in force from 01.10.2014 to 30.09.2015.
- 6.0 All other terms and conditions as stipulated in Rates Circular No 60 of 2009, 15 of 2010, 23 of 2013 will continue to apply unchanged.
- 7.0 This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.



2.0 The percentage rebate indicated above would remain in force from 01-10-2013 to 30-09-2014.

3.0 The rebate will be applicable for the stream(s) notified by the Operating Department of the Zonal Railways in consultation with Traffic Transportation Directorate in the Ministry of Railways from time to time.

4.0 The rebate in freight charges for both Ammonia (Anhydrous Liquefied Gas) and Phosphoric Acid in privately owned tank wagons may be allowed at the time of booking in respect of those parties who have paid the annual maintenance charges in advance at the commencement of the year. The transfer of tank wagon from owner of such wagons to parties hiring such wagons for transportation of the commodities should have the prior approval of Traffic Transportation Directorate of the Ministry of Railways. Prior to notification of the rebate in freight to parties involved, the Railway may enter into agreement with the parties for the transportation of the above mentioned commodities in privately owned wagons.
