Sub: Exemption from mandatory weighment in case of low density commodities

(ii) Board's letter No.TC-I/2017/109/3 dt.23.05.2018(Addendum 4 to Rates Master Circular/Weightment 2014/0)
(iii) Board's letter No.TC-I/2017/109/3 dt.13.06.2018

In terms of Addendum under reference (ii), dispensation from mandatory(100%) weighment of wagon/rake loaded with Petroleum Coke and/or Metallurgical Coke has been permitted with a proviso that atleast 5% of rakes should be subjected to weighment. These guidelines are valid upto 26.05.2019.

The matter has been reviewed and it has been decided to extend the currency of above-mentioned guidelines beyond 26.05.2019 **till further advice**

However, guidelines to permit weighment of Petroleum Coke and/or Metallurgical Coke on the request of consignor as prescribed vide Board's letter No.TC-I/2017/109/3 dt.13.06.2018 will continue to apply unchanged.

This issues in consultation with Traffic Transportation Dte. and with the concurrence of Finance Dte. of Ministry of Railways.
