

STATISTICAL ORGANISATION

Organizational Set up:- Statistical organization is functioning under the administrative control of FA&CAO(WST). As desired by Railway Board vide D.O. no. 2015/Stat-I/1 dtd. 13.10.2015 of FC/ Rly. Bd. and subsequent notification no. ECoR/Accts/BBS/Admn-G/DAC dtd. 02.12.2015 of FA&CAO/ ECoR, this branch is functioning as a part of the newly formed Data Analytical Centre headed by Data Analytical Officer (JAG/ SG) at Head Quarters' office. Works of the Statistical branch are being looked after by S & AO along with 03 Senior Inspectors and 22 ministerial staff. Out of 03 Sr. Inspectors, two are posted in divisions and one is in head quarter. The 22 Ministerial staff includes 05 Chief OS, 07 OS, 02 Sr. Clerks, 06 Jr. Clerks and two General Assistants.

Objective:- The main objective of the Statistical organization is to appraise the top management at specific time intervals regarding factual position of current period progress compared to that of previous period achievements. This comparison enables the management to make better and efficient future planning. Statistical data compiled in a systematic manner are of great importance for exercising proper managerial control and formulation of policy.

Activities:- To highlight the comparative performance vis-à-vis target and pinpoint the areas of deterioration for the purpose of appraisal of top management and to help them to monitor the performance in a better way the Statistical organization is involved in compilation of various statistical statements periodically, monthly, quarterly and annually. During the year 2018-19, compilation work of all the annual statistical statements along with periodical, monthly and quarterly statements has been executed at Statistical Branch at Head Quarters office/ ECoR successfully in time .

Besides the regular compilation activities as stated above, this organization brings out the following publications too for general and managerial information within the time frame.

- a) General Manager's Annual Narrative Report.
- b) Pocket Book on Financial Results and Important Statistical Highlights.
- c) Domestic Statistics (Divisional Performance):- Part-I on Traffic operation, Part-IIA on Mechanical/ Electrical operations & Part-II B&C on Fuel & Lubricant Statistics.
- d) Station Code List of the zone.
