





Sub: Hiring-cum-Haulage Charges for Test Wagons.

- 1) In terms of Board's Rates Circular No. 17 of 2018 dated 12.10.2018 (Para (ii) of page 2) a uniform distance of 100KM per weighbridge was advised to be reckoned for all private parties to examine accuracy of their weighbridges.
- 2) The matter has been reviewed keeping in view the objective of ensuring due calibration of weighbridges and it has now been decided to substitute, Para (ii) of Page 2 of the Rates Circular No. 17 of 2018 as under:

“(ii) A uniform distance of 100 Km per weighbridge shall be reckoned for all gauges whenever Railway owned test wagons are demanded on hire by private parties to examine accuracy of their weighbridge. However, in case where there are more than one weighbridges located within one siding/PFT/ICD etc., a distance of 100 km shall be reckoned for charging of the first weighbridge and for every additional weighbridge, the test wagon charges shall be @ 25% of the charges for first weighbridge. Any other charges and GST shall be levied separately.”
- 3) These instructions shall come into force w.e.f. 10.08.2019 and shall remain in force till further advice.
- 4) All other terms and conditions of Rates circular No.17 of 2018 shall remain unchanged.
- 5) This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of Ministry of Railways.


