
In terms of Railway Board's letter No. E(NG)-II/2007/RC-4/Core/1 dated 28.11.2019 & letter No. E(NG)-II/2005/RC-4/SC/2Pt1 dated 01.07.2020, it has been decided to fill up the vacancy in Central Hospital against ex-cadre post of East Coast Railway by re-engagement of retired Railway employees as per the terms and conditions given below:

Terms and Conditions of re-engagement of retired employees.

1. The currency of said ex-cadre post is valid up to **25.10.2020**.
2. Employees retired from Pharmacist cadre of medical department in Railway services can apply against the post.
3. The re-engagement shall be strictly up to the age of 65 years or up to **25.10.2020** or till the availability of regular candidates from RRB/Departmental Selections etc., whichever is earlier, unless extended by Competent Authority.
4. The administration is at liberty to terminate the services of the re-engaged employees even before 25.10.2020 in case their work/conduct is found unsatisfactory.
5. The employees Removed/Dismissed/Compulsory retired as a result of disciplinary action or in review are not eligible for re-engagement. Further, employees retired under SRRS/LARSGESS will not be eligible.

6. The re-engaged staff will be paid monthly remuneration determined by reducing pension from his/her last pay drawn (i.e., Basic+ DA) in such that pension plus contractual remuneration should not exceed the last pay drawn at the time of retirement. The re-engaged employees are not entitled for any other benefits or facilities except the monthly remuneration.
7. The retired employee shall execute an agreement to abide by all the terms and conditions of the re-engagement.
8. Re-engagement shall be subject to prescribed medical fitness for the post.
9. Suitability/Competency of the applicant shall be adjudged by competent authority before their re-engagement through Service record, Skill and Safety record as well as the Safety and other operational requirement as needed are adequately addressed.
10. The re-engaged retired employee will have to give 7 day's notice for discontinuing the service.
11. Re-engaged employees shall be on duty on normal duty hours followed by the office in which they will be posted. The duty hours can be changed as per the requirement of work by the administration. They will be eligible for weekly off and General Holidays observed by the office in which they will be posted. The re-engaged employee will be eligible for 8 days leave (on Prorata basis) in a calendar year. For absence (beyond sanctioned leave)if any, appropriate deduction will be made from the monthly remuneration.
12. Self attested copies of the following documents should mandatorily be attached with the application :
 - a) Service certificate.
 - b) Pensioner identity Card
 - c) Pension payment order
 - d) Aadhar Card.
13. The last date for submission of the application is **05.10.2020**
14. The staff retired from Railways desirous for re-engagement for the above posts, should send their applications by post in the prescribed format in Annexure 'A' addressed to **The Principal Chief Personnel Officer, East Coast Railway, South Block, 2nd Floor, South Block, Rail Sadan, Chandrasekharpur, Bhubaneswar, Odisha-751017** to reach on or before **05.10.2020**. Alternatively, the retired staff can drop their applications directly in Drop Box placed at the office premises of PCPO's office **on or before 05.10.2020**. **Application received after due closing date/time, for any reason whatsoever, will not be considered.**
