

Bhubaneswar Railway Station

1. Brief Description



Bhubaneswar is an ancient city and the capital of Odisha state in Eastern India. It is known as Sports capital of India and also known as Temple city of India. It is a centre of economic, tourism, educational and cultural importance of East India. Many temples built from sandstone are dotted around Bindu Sagar lake in old city, including 11th century Hindu Lingraja Temple. Bhubaneswar Railway Station is NSG-2(A1 Class) category Station of Khurda Road Division of East Coast Railway in Indian Railway. Bhubaneswar railway station serves Bhubaneswar, the capital of Odisha and is the headquarters of the East Coast Railway zone of the Indian railway. It is situated in the main line of Howrah-Chennai Railway line. More than 50,000 passengers travel through Bhubaneswar Railway station on daily Basis. An average foot fall of 35,000 nos. is dealt here on daily basis.
