

ICHCHAPURAM RAILWAY STATION

1. Brief Description



Ichchapuram is a town in the Srikakulam District of the Indian state of Andhra Pradesh. Ichchapuram lies on the boarder of Andhra Pradesh and Odisha. Ichapuram municipality is the largest ULB in the Srikakulam District. The town is located nearly 142 km from the district capital. Ichchapuram Railway station is on the Howrah-Chennai main line under Kurdha Road Railway Division of East Coast Railway Zone. The station code is IPM. Ichchapuram is the education hub for its surrounding villages. There are several private schools including Vidhya Bharathi English medium school, Swarna Bharathi English medium school, Gnana Bharathi English medium school, and Ravindra Bharathi English medium school. Children from surrounding villages comes to Ichchapuram for pursuing education via passenger trains. Coconut Business serves as the basic occupation for the locals. The main tourist attractions are hindu temples like Ratneshwara Siva Temple, Swechavathi Ammavari Devasthanam Temple and Gandhi Park situated in Ichchapuram. One can visit a large number of renowned places with few kilometers out of the town. Among them, Telineelapuram, Vishhnu-Kurmavatora Temple, Salihundam Buddhist Remnant site and Sri Endala Mallikarjuna Swamy Temple are the most popular ones.
