DRM's Message

The area served by Sambalpur Division is endowed with natural resources and has a good potential for economic growth. "Indian Railways" – The lifeline of this nation, through Sambalpur Division, is playing a vital role in the socio-economic development of the region. Sambalpur Division covers 9 districts of Odisha and 2 districts of Chhattisgarh.

The Division achieved freight loading of 12.507 MT during the fiscal year 2020-21 which is 14.08 % higher than 2019-20. 161.26 freight trains were interchanged per day with adjacent divisions during this period which is 17.88 % higher than the previous year.

Sambalpur Division is committed to give 100% satisfaction to the rail users. Free Wi-Fi service has been provided at all stations over Sambalpur Division. Passenger Reservation System (PRS) has been installed at 48 stations including 06 postal and 05 Non-Rail Head PRS over Sambalpur Division. Automatic Ticket Vending Machines have been provided at 14 stations (24 Nos.).

Sambalpur Division is having 739.465 Route KM and 1593.394 Track KM. 06 Nos. Limited Height Subways (LHS) have been constructed and 04 Nos. of additional Foot Over Bridges have been constructed at Bagbahara, Khariar Road, Junagarh Road and Doikalu stations during 2020-21.

Four stations of SBP Division i.e. Sambalpur, Balangir, Titlagarh and Kesinga have received ISO 14001 : 2015 Environmental Management System Certificate for providing passenger amenities and allied services in clean and green environment throughout the premises.

Sambalpur division has bagged 7 efficiency shields in 65th Railway week celebration-2020 at Zonal level for best performance in Civil Engineering, Coaching Depot, Signal & Telecom, Safety, Security, Scrap disposal and Operating (jointly with WAT division).
