1. The scheme of hiring of para-medical categories in Group "C" on contract basis over and above the sanctioned strength is valid up to 30.09.2021, as per Railway Board's letter No. E(NG)II/2005/RC-4/SC/2 Pt-1 dated 30.03.2021.
 2. The guidelines issued vide Railway Board's Letter. No. E(NG)II/2004/RC-4/SC/2 dated 19.07.2005 (RBE No.119/2005) and letter No.E(NG)II/2005/RC-4/SC/2 dtd 22.06.2017 are to be followed. The daily rate of deduction from the remuneration for excess absence beyond the contract shall be on pro-rata basis.
 3. They have to execute a fresh individual agreement with Railway Administration and submit the same through MD/CH/BBS duly countersigned, to the undersigned for record.
 4. Unsatisfactory performance, mentally or physically incapacitation for the service may debar them to continue and make them liable for termination at short notice.
 5. The contract may also be terminated at any time during the contract period by giving 15 days notice from either side without assigning any reason thereof.
 6. The above re-engagement is purely on contract basis and have no right or privileges governing to the regular/temporary employees, are applicable to them.
 7. Their date of reporting to CH/BBS may be intimated to this office for record.
