

CITATION

Sri Chandra Dhawj Majhi, PM'A'/KSNG is a dedicated and efficient worker. He is known for his determination & sincerity towards duty. On 20.08.2020, he was on duty at the traffic LC Gate No. RV-172 at KM 215/2. The gate was closed at 23:30 Hrs for passage of 08448 Koraput – Bhubaneswar Express which had left Kandel Road at 23:28 Hrs. After closure of the gate for road traffic, a police patrolling jeep arrived at the gate and the officials demanded to open the gate. Since the gate is interlocked with the reception signal (Home signal) and the reception signal was taken off for admission of 08448 Koraput – Bhubaneswar Express, **the police officials were requested by the Gate Keeper to wait for few minutes.** Interlocking of the gate does not permit to open the gate before the reception signal is put back to 'ON' position and the running time of 08448 Exp between Kandel Road - Kesinga is only 6/7 minutes. However, the police officials got annoyed without any provocation and they started scolding the Gate Keeper in filthy language, took him away to the police station where he was severely beaten. After that, he was taken to the local hospital where the Doctor did not render any treatment nor gave any medicine. The police officials forced Sri Chandra Dhawj Majhi to sign on a blank paper and then dropped him at Kesinga Railway station at about 01:30 Hrs. Sri Chandra Dhawj Majhi sustained injury on his face, hands & knees and was unable to continue his duty.

The guts shown by Sri Chandra Dhawj Majhi not to open the gate in front of 08448 Koraput – Bhubaneswar Express to ensure the safety of the passengers and locals irrespective of the physical & moral assault made by the police officials is praise worthy. As such, Sri Chandra Dhawj Majhi, Point Man 'A'/KSNG is recommended for 'Man of the Month' award as a piece of appreciation for the good works done by him and to boost the morale of the co-workers.
