Each railway unit of Indian Railways is in possession of numerous extremely valuable billable assets. The non-availability of centralized records of such billable assets constitutes a serious deterrent to the correct realization of dues to the railways, since it is only with correct, comprehensive, identification & listing of such assets, that proper billing can be done.

In this regard, Board vide letter dated 26.12.2019 had desired that each railway unit must maintain a digitized database of all billable assets in the utility created in IPAS. This will greatly help the Railways to efficiently identify and monitor outstanding dues by easing the process of tracking of such assets.

It is however observed that Railways are not uploading the list of Billable Assets in the said Utility (for Billable assets). It is urgently requested that an Action on this subject may kindly be submitted to Board's office on the email aaocrb@gmail.com by September 8, 2021 positively.
