Sub: Old non-moving materials lying idle in stores

As per the old non-moving materials list submitted by your office vide reference (ii), it has been found that a large number of materials procured long back and lying idle in the S&T stores for a long time. No step has been taken to dispose of these materials. This indicates that the procurement has not been done judiciously.

These materials could have been utilized by other units of ECoR or other railways if the information would have been circulated in time or these could have been condemned if not required. Not only these block the revenue of Railway which could be generated from its sale but also the materials are losing its value due to delay in its disposal.

In the above context the following guidelines may be adhered to:

- (i) Procurement of materials should be done judiciously to avoid accumulation of materials in the store.
- (ii) Inventory management system to be implemented in each consignee depot and review to be done in every six months for non-moving materials by concerned officer in charge of the store.
- (iii) Immediate steps must be taken for disposal of non-moving materials which will not be used in future by Railways.

Action taken in this regard may be intimated to this office.
