

Sambalpur Division

Freight Information:

Sambalpur Division is one of the three constituent Division of East Coast Railway, having 62 block stations in which 55 are in Odisha State and 07 are in Chhattisgarh State, spanning over 739.465 route km stand and 1426.43 Track kms. All the station are equipped with PI/EI with multiaspector colour light (MACL) signalling system. Also, the jurisdiction with 05 Interchange point viz Theruvali (THV) with Visakhapatnam Division, Arangmahanadi (ANMD) with Raipur Division, Jarapada (JRPD) with KUR Division and Jharsuguda Road with Bilaspur (BSP) and Chakradharpur (CKP) Division. The Division mainly transports Food Grain, Aluminium Powder, Steel, Coal, Cement & Iron Ore as Outward Traffic and Fertilizer, Cement, Coal, Coke, Bauxite, Iron Ore & Other Minerals as Inward Traffic.

Loading point of Sambalpur Division:

There are 11 Private siding and 17 nos. of Goods Shed, over the Division. Private Siding of M/s Vedanta (MAVB & SEBD)/Brundamal (BXQ), M/s Bhushan Power Steel Ltd. (BPSL)/Lapanga, M/s Aryan Ispat & Power Pvt. Ltd (MAIL)/Lapanga, M/s Vedanta (MVAA)/Ambodala, M/s Hindalco (MAAL)/Lapanga, The Associated Cement Co. Ltd. (CFDS)/Bargarh, Indian Metal & Ferro Alloys (IMFT)/Theruvali, Hirkud Industrial Works Ltd. (HIWs)/Sambalpur, Pvt Siding of M/s Shyam Metallic (SMER) & Ordnance Factory (OFB)/BUDM.

Goods Shed over the Division : Lapanga, Maneswar, Rengali, Sambalpur City, Handapa, Hirkud, Bargarh, Bolangir, Durgripali, Kesinga, Junagarh Road, Kantabanji, Khariar Road, Belsonda, & Komakhan goods shed.

Coaching Performance :

There are 46 pairs of Mail/Express trains and 11 pairs of passenger trains are running across the Division. 01 coaching depot is situated at Sambalpur Division.
