Sub: Advisory to ensure stoppage of payment of long absentees.

During vigilance check, it was noticed that the staff under long absence have been paid salary for their absent period. In another case, salary in favour of a long absentee was drawn for a month in which the penalty of removal has been effected. In the case, recovery of the irregular payment has not been initiated by concerned unit until the matter is pointed out by Vigilance Dept.

2. Vide letters under reference, it was already advised to issue directions to all concerned regarding that staff absented more than a month should be kept under "Stop Salary Option" in order to curb irregular payments in favour of the absentees. Moreover, it may strictly be ensured that staff imposed with penalties such as removal, dismissal, etc must not be paid salaries by promptly placing them out of "Staff Roll" or by using stop salary option in IPAS.

3. In this respect, it is reiterated that the bill clerks concerned may be advised to stop paying salaries by using stop salary option in IPAS for all the staff unauthorisedly absenting more than a month. Action taken report may please be communicated to this office for appraisal and record.
