

GOOD WORK DONE BY RPF/ECOR FOR THE PERIOD FROM 01.04.2023 TO 30.04.2023.

1. On 30.03.2023, basing upon a Rail Madad complaint officer and staff of RPF/Post/Puri retrieved a left behind Silver colour laptop valued-42,000/- from Train No.18451 (HATIA-PURI) Exp. The retrieved mobile phone was handed over to its rightful owner viz. Janmejay Jena under proper acknowledgement..

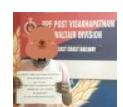
