Sub:-Cadre Re-structuring in the Ministrial category in Railway Claims Tribunal Ref:- Railway Board's letter No. 2022/TC(RCT)/1-4 dated 24-07-2024

In reference to Board's letter cited above, the detailed reply on the queries/ observation of Railway Board on the subject are furnished below:-

	Observation of Railway Board	Reply/ Comments
1	Salary and other allowances of staff posted in RCT are paid by the concerned ZR/Division or by RCT Directly	Salary and other allowances of staff of RCT are paid by RCT itself directly not by the Zonal Railways.
3	Is the post against which staff are posted in RCT are out of the total sanctioned strength under ZR/Division or the post of RCT against which posting order is issued by the Zone/Division is over and above the Zone/Division Strength i.e., against the sanctioning strength of RCT which is over above the ZR's sanctioned strength for example if COS post at L-7 in RCT is 20 whether this 20 post is covered under the total sanctioned strength of ZR or it is over and above sanctioned strength of ZR; Are all post of RCT in question viz Clerk/Caretaker, Sr Clerk, OS/Court Master and COS are filed by Railway Staff of a Zone or even through any other mode viz outsourcing or staff from any other Department;	The posting of staff by Zonal Railways in RCT are made against the permanent sanctioned posts of RCT not against the sanctioned strength of Zonal Railways. The sanctioned posts in the Ministerial Cadre for the Benches of RCT by Railway Board are not clubbed with Zonal Railways and these are separate sanctioned strength of RCT. The re-structured posts of COS,OS, Sr. Clerk, Clerk due to implementation of cadre restructuring are within the sanctioned strength of RCT. All the posts i.e. viz. Clerk/Caretaker, Sr. Clerk, OS/Court Master and Ch. OS in RCT are filled by Zonal Railway/Division on transfer basis not through any other mode viz. Outsourcing or staff from any other department.
1	For posting at RCT is there any system of selection or simply transfer by the Zone from their existing sanction strength;	There is no system of selection for posting in RCT. The applications are invited by Zonal Railways from willing staff on transfer basis in analogues grade and are posted/transferred in RCT in same Pay and Grade against permanent sanctioned posts of RCT.

When a particular staff who has been posted at RCT gets promoted to higher post on ZR whether that concerned staff is asked to report to ZR for further posting or the upgraded element to which the staff has been promoted is transferred to RCT and existing element is utilized at ZR;

When the staff of Zonal Railway gets promotion in his parent department of Zonal Railways, they are repatriated to their department to get their promotion affected in higher grade in Zonal Railways. In case there is vacant post in RCT due to up gradation/restructuring in higher grade, the Zonal Railway is requested to post them against the post of RCT on transfer basis. Upgraded element of RCT is utilized only to accommodate the employees if promoted in parent department and ordered to be posted by zonal Railway against re-structured post RCT post in anologus grade.

Is Ministerial cadre of RCT for which restructuring is proposed as mentioned in RCT's Notification RCT/DLI/AdmnPolicy/2021 dated 27.04.2022 are the only post which are operated at RCT by the ZR or these are exclusive post of RCT filled up on transfer basis by ZR. When was last (date and order No) up gradation/restructuring of Ministerial cadre at RCT carried out?

The restructuring proposed and implemented in RCT for up gradation vide notification dated 27.04.2022 are against the permanent posts of RCT not against the post of Zonal Railways. No up- gradation/restructuring in RCT has taken placed & implemented in Ministerial Cadre since 1989. This is first restructuring implemented in the Ministerial Category of RCT against its sanctioned permanent post by Railway Board as per the guidelines/ instructions contained in RBE No.102/13 by matching saving/surrendering of the post subject to the following conditions:-

1. That the Railway employees working in RCT on transfer basis from zonal Railways will not be promoted against

these re-structured posts.

2. These re-structured post will be filled from regular Railway employees in analogous grade from zonal Railways on transfer basis as per instructions issued by Railway Board.

3. Against these re-structured post of COS and 0S, Sr. Clerk, Clerk, in Ministerial cadre, a Railway staff of Zonal Railway working in RCT Benches on transfer basis, if promoted in their parent department of Zonal Railways in higher grade can be retained with the order from zonal

Railway if re- structured post is available in RCT.

Whether the proposed restructuring are still a proposal or already implemented and only post facto approval is being sought. Restructuring against the permanent posts of RCT in Ministerial category has been implemented in the RCT on the recommendation of committee constituted of three Member Committee comprising Members (Tech) with the approval of Hon'ble Chairman, RCT, Delhi who as per Rules (4) of Railway Claims Tribunal(Financial & Administrative Powers) Rules 1989 shall have the same power in respect of Administrative & Financial matters as are conferred on General Manager. This issues with concurrence of Associate Finance of RCT.
