GENERAL TERMS & CONDTIONS

“Establishing and Maintaining of Free Emergency Medical Centre” at major Railway Stations of Waltair Division (on Non Revenue basis)to provide free emergency medical assistance to the bonafide passengers during the course of their train journey”. For the purpose Expression of interest for one year invited from willing Hospitals/Group of Hospitals for the following Railway Stationsas per following terms and conditions.

1. The primary aim to establish Emergency Medical Room at Railway Stations is to provide “First aid Medical assistance” free of cost to bonafide Railway passengers who have been injured due to falling from train/run over cases/etc. during the course of their train journey.
2. Applicants can be parties/Corporate/Hospitals/Group of Hospitals having establishment and infrastructure in Visakhapatnam and having minimum 03 years experience in Medical field.
3. The contract will be for a period of one year, renewable yearly with no maximum limit, subject to satisfactory performance of selected party.
4. Selected party is bounded to provide free emergency medical assistance to the bonafide passengers on station call. EMR will be connected by the Railway phone and it is Doctor on duty responsibility to attend the passengeronboard with all medical aid on station call. Serious ill or injured passengers will be transported by the EMR staff to the nearest Govt. Hospital where ICU/trauma facilities should be available.

All the station call should be maintained in a separate register in duplicate and records should be communicated to the Railway Medical official fortnightly. If the contractor fails to attend medical assistance call, it will lead to terminationof the contract without any noticeor a suitable penalty as deemed fit will be imposed by the Railway administration.

It is EMR responsibility to attend Railway accidental site along with the Railway medical team in SPART and take part in the restoration/ treatment/transportation of injured patient.

5. The emergency service provider shall provide medical services Round the Clock in emergency Medical Room.
6. The arrangement of foldable Stretcher, wheel chair, reclining bed, stools and necessary medical boxes as per with inventories recommended by AIIMS (Annexure-I) should be available in EMR.
7. Railway will provide space, electricity and water connectivity free of cost in Visakhapatnam Railway station.
8. The selected party shall construct the booth for the medical facility as per plan approved by Railways at its own cost and by mobilizing its own resources.
9. Emergency Service Provider is permitted to setup a small pharmacy in the EMR for sale of medicines to the other bonafide Passengers/commuters.
10. The selected party should not canvas/promote their hospital/firm through this centre. Whereas selected Hospital can fix their nameboard in front of the Centre.
11. Biomedical waste generated during the contract should be disposed as per existing norms; by the bidder, charges for the same will be borne by the bidder.

12. Emergency Medical Room should be provided with all fire safety norms.
13. Any damage done to Railway property during execution of work will have to be borne by the selected party at its own cost.
14. The Selected party is the independent employer and all persons employed or engaged by the party to carry out the said work under this proposal shall be its employees and not of the Railways.
15. The Railway Administration shall not be responsible in any way for loss or damage by any means to the Emergency Medical Service Provider's stock or property.
16. Railways shall be indemnified of any claim /disputes arising on account of the usage of the services of the Centre by the passengers.
17. Railway will not be responsible for any outcome arising due to Medical Attention provide at the Centre.
18. The EOI contract may be terminated by either party by giving three months notice and the selected party will be permitted to take back any Equipment installed by them on termination
19. Any dispute arising out of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with selected party will be settled by Divisional Railway Manager, Waltair Division, East Coast Railway, whose decision will be final and binding on both Railways and Selected party. The jurisdiction is limited to Courts in Visakhapatnam only.
20. In case if there is more than one applicant, the applicant who has offered all essential facilities will be preferred over others. In case if there is more than one applicant offering all essential facilities, the preference will be based on the recommended facilities offered by the applicants. **Which will be finalised by the 03 members of Senior Railway Doctors nominated by the CMS/WAT on grading basis as mentioned in Annexure –II. Preference will be given to the NABH accredited Hospital and more experienced hospital in this field.**
21. Interested parties/organization may apply with their plan/drawing/design of the proposed centre and its specifications, capability and experience in such nature of work.
22. Interested parties/Corporates/Hospital/Group of Hospitals are requested to give expression of interest in the format attached at Annexure-II and submit along with all required details/documents in the separate sealed cover super scribed as “EOI for free Emergency Medical Facility Centre at Visakhapatnam Railway Station” through Registered post/Courier/in person so as to reach office of chief medical superintendent, Divisional Railway Hospital, Dondaparthi, Visakhapatnam – 530004 before 15 hours of 6th November 2024 and will be opened on same day and will be put up to competent authority for acceptance or otherwise. Successful bidder will be informed & on issue of Letter of acceptance, the bidder should start the unit within one month and MOU to be signed.

25. The selected party has to enter with MOU for the proposed work and provide all emergency medicines as per list of emergency medicines approved by AIIMS, equipments and etc.






