- 1) Applications are invited to fill up 01 (One) vacancy of ex-cadre post of Vigilance Inspector / S&T in Pay Matrix Level- 7 (Scale of Rs. 9300-34800/- in Grade Pay Rs. 4600/- 6th CPC) in vigilance organization North Western Railway Jaipur. The tenure of the post will normally be for three (03) years, which may be curtailed / extended as per extant rules.
- 2) **Eligibility:-**
 - (i) Staff of the Signal & Telecommunication Department of Indian Railway Working in Pay Matrix Level-6 & 7 (Scale of Rs. 9300-34800/- in Grade Pay Rs. 4200/- & 4600/- 6th CPC) as J.E / SSE on regular basis on the date of notification. The staff who have got financial up-gradation from Level-7 to Level-8 under Group 'C' cadre is also eligible for the post to apply.
 - (ii) The staff should have completed at least five (05) years service in Railway as on date of notification.
 - (iii) Staff who have already completed their tenure in the vigilance organization of Zonal Railways / Production Units/ Railway Board earlier as Vigilance Inspector / Investigating Inspector (Vigilance) are not eligible to apply. However, if they have completed required cooling off period (minimum 02 years) as on 30.11.2024, thereafter they are also eligible to apply.
 - (iv) Integrity of staff should be beyond doubt. Staff should have clear Vigilance history and should not have undergone any penalty in Vigilance/SPE case. Also the staff should not have undergone / undergoing any penalty under DAR in the last 03 years.
 - (v) Working knowledge of computer is essential.
- 3) **Wide publicity of the above vacancy notice may kindly be given and this should also be displayed prominently on notice boards for information of the staff:** Controlling officers are requested to forward the applications of those employees who have not undergone any penalty in Vigilance/ SPE case during their service period and employees who have not undergone any penalty under DAR in the last 03 years, should only be forwarded. 4) **Procedure for submission of application:-**

5) **Service sheets & APARs:** To avoid delay, attested true copies of the updated service sheets and certified copies of the APARs for the last three years (i.e. period ending 31.03.2022, 31.03.2023 & 31.03.2024) in respect of all the applications should be sent collectively by the concerned Personnel Branch of the Unit/Division/HQ along with the applications.

6) Suitability of the candidate will be ascertained through interview/APARs/ credibility. Date of interview will be informed in due course.

7) Vigilance is an ex-cadre organization. Therefore, staff selected for posting in the Vigilance department will continue to maintain their lien and seniority in their parent cadre/Unit/Railway. Staff selected will not have any right to absorb in North Western Railway. The normal establishment rules applicable to regular selection posts are not applicable in the selection of Vigilance Inspectors (as per Para No. 821.5 of the Indian Railway Vigilance Manual-2018).



In order to fill up ex-cadre post of **Chief Vigilance Inspector/S&T** in Pay Matrix Level-7 (scale of Rs.9300-34800 in Grade Pay of Rs.4600/- of 6th CPC) in the Vigilance organization E.C. Railway/Hajipur, it has been decided to hold a selection for forming a panel of ONE (01) candidate from the technical staff of **S&T** Department. The tenure of the post will normally be for three (03) years, which may be curtailed/extended as per extant rules.

Eligibility:

- (i) Staff working as SSE/JE in Signal & Telecom department of Indian Railways in Level-7 (scale of Rs.9300-34800 in Grade Pay of Rs.4600/- of 6th CPC) or one Level below in level - 6 (i.e. in scale of Rs. 9300-34800 with G.P. 4200/- in 6th CPC) on regular basis on the date of notification.
- (ii) The staff should have completed at least five (05) years service in Railways as on date of notification.
- (iii) Staff who have already completed their tenure in the Vigilance Organization of Zonal Railways/Units/Railway Board as Vigilance Inspector/Chief Vigilance Inspector/Investigating Inspector (Vigilance) are not eligible to apply. However, if they have completed sufficient cooling off period (i.e. minimum 02 years) as on date of notification, thereafter they are also eligible to apply.
- (iv) The integrity of the staff should be beyond doubt. Staff should have clear Vigilance history and should not have undergone any penalty in Vigilance/SPE case. Also the staff should not have undergone/undergoing any penalty under DAR in the last 3 years.
- (v) Working knowledge of computer is essential.

The selection will comprise of a written test followed by a Vigilance Aptitude and Computer Knowledge Test. In the written test, questions may be asked from the Railway Servants (D&AR) Rule 1968, Railway Servants (Conduct) Rules 1966, Establishment matters, Rajbhasha, General Awareness and Codes, Manual matters pertaining to Signal & Telecom Department etc.,







Sub: - Selection for filling up of Ex Cadre Tenure posts of Chief Vigilance Inspectors/ Vigilance Inspectors in Pay Matrix Level -7 (GP 4600) of Medical department at Vigilance office, Headquarter office, Churchgate.

1. Selection

In order to fill up ex-cadre posts of Chief Vigilance Inspector in Pay matrix level 7 in Vigilance department, Headquarter office, Western Railway Churchgate, Mumbai, it has been decided to hold a selection for forming a panel of 02(Two) candidates in Medical department.

2. No. of Vacancies – 02 (Two)

3. Reservation of Vacancies:-

The posts of CVIs/VIs being Ex. cadre tenure posts, there is no provision for reservation of vacancies for employees of reserved category. However, the employees belonging to reserved category may be encouraged to apply.

4. Eligibility:-

- a) The staff holding any of the post given in eligibility list at para-5 working in Medical department in Pay Matrix- 7 or one level below i.e. in level 6 on regular basis are eligible. He should have completed at least 5 years in Level 6 or above.

Staff working in Level 8 and Level 9 of pay matrix are also eligible to apply for the post. However the staff selected for the post of CVI/VI will be transferred to Vigilance office along with the post of Level 8/9 and the element of post in Level 7 in Vigilance office will be transferred to the lien unit if needed.

- b) The posts of Vigilance Inspector being ex-cadre tenure post, the employees found suitable will be posted as CVI/VI in the same scale of pay held by them at HQ/CCG. The normal tenure of the post is three years which could be extended for a further period of two years only on the basis of performance. On completion of the tenure, the staff would be repatriated to the respective parent cadre on the railway where he holds lien. However the staff selected for the post could be repatriated at any time on or before completion of tenure.
- c) He should not have exceeded 55 years of age.

- d) After transfer of an official from Vigilance unit, irrespective of the period for which he has served there, he should undergo a cooling period of at least two years before being considered for posting in vigilance unit again, if necessary.
- e) He should be willing to perform arduous duties.
- f) Staff should have proven integrity. Vigilance history and reputation of the official should be checked minutely. He should not be figuring in any current vigilance/SPE/DAR case and should not have been imposed any major/minor penalty in any past vigilance/CBI case at any time.
- g) However, applications in the following situations will also be considered for the post of Vigilance Inspectors as per the provisions of Paras 821.1 of IRVM, 2018.
 - I. Where a person was issued a major / minor penalty Charge-sheet in a vigilance case but was subsequently exonerated at a later stage in consultation with Vigilance.
 - II. Where a staff who was issued verbal / recorded warning or counseling in a vigilance case.
 - III. Where a staff was issued verbal / recorded warning or counseling in a vigilance case and at a subsequent stage was exonerated in consultation with Vigilance.
- h) Employees who are computer trained and have familiarity of WINDOWS, Programming skills and knowledge of hardware are desirable.

5. STAFF ELIGIBILITY FOR SELECTION FOR THE POSTS OF CVIs/VIs.

6. SELECTION PROCEDURE.

Written examination consists of one question paper of 2 hrs. The venue and date of written examination will be advised separately. The tentative date of written examination will be 23.01.2025. Candidates who obtain 60% marks in written examination will be called for appearing in the Vigilance Aptitude & Computer Knowledge test. The distribution of marks for selection is given below:
